Entry Fee: \$9 per competitor per series event; irrespective of categories entered (Board & Ski Series events only).

Competitor Caps: Compulsory

Entries: Entries will close **Thursday 2nd September, 11pm before event.**

Clubs will be responsible for entering their competitors using the SLSWA online entry system and will be invoiced directly for entries. Competitors may only enter one category per discipline but may enter different categories across different disciplines (e.g. U/17 Ski & Open Board). Competitors will need to enter each category they wish to compete in (e.g. U/19 Ski and U/17 Board).

Registration: Competitors will be required to register before the event; between **8.00am & 8.30am** the morning of the event. Competitors will have a number marked on their left and right hand which will be used to identify the competitor (particularly for results recording).



Pre-Race Briefing: A competitors briefing will take place at **8.45am**. During the briefing competitors will be notified of any changes to the race course, safety requirements, program of events/starting order, course, craft/equipment requirements, start instructions and finish requirements.

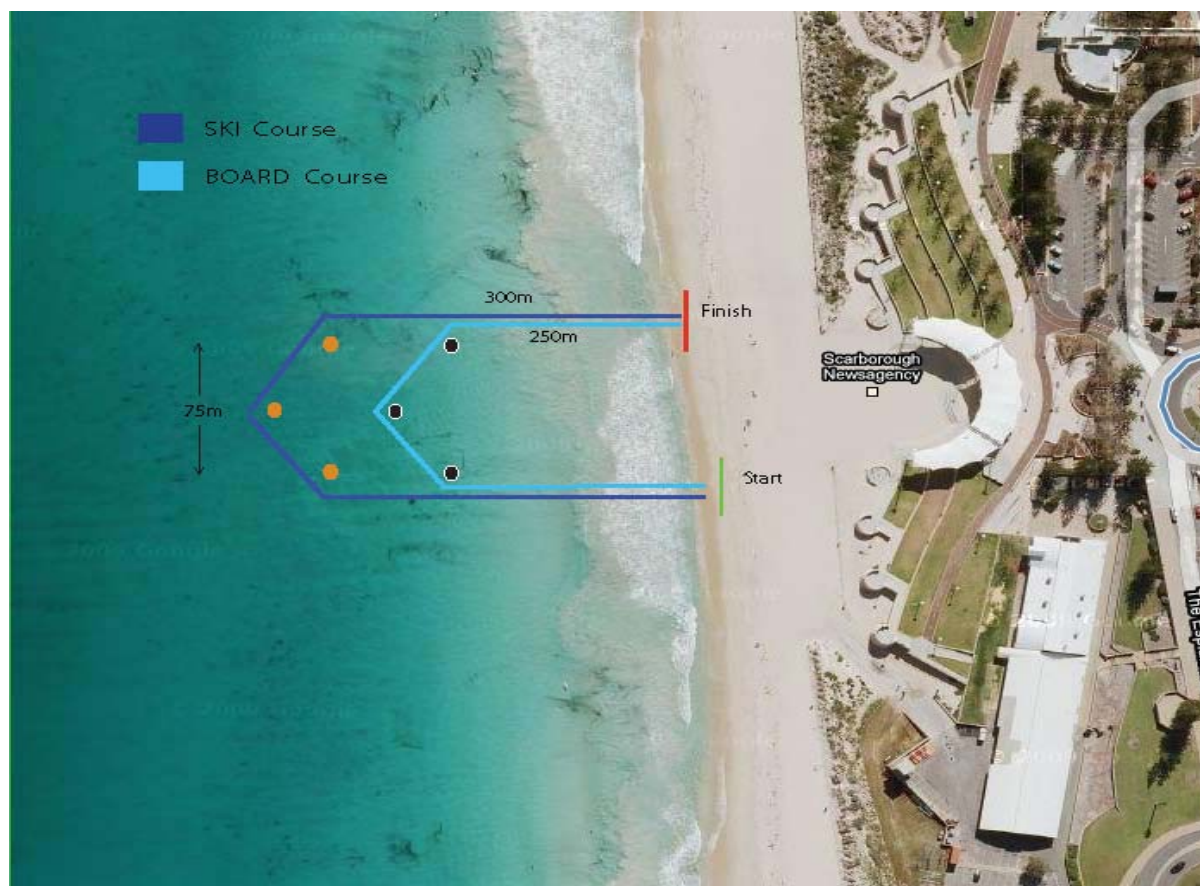
Competitor requirements (registered & proficient): *Competitors must be registered and financial for the current season with their club.* All competitors entered in the series event must be proficient SRC or Bronze holders. It is the clubs responsibility to ensure any competitor entering the event has the necessary requirements for the category they are entered into. The exception to this will be previous U/15 competitors moving up into the U/17 age category who are proficient SRC holders (expiry 31/12/2010) but have not as yet completed their Bronze Medallion. These competitors will be granted an amnesty period (end 31st October 2010) in which they can compete in 2010 SLSWA Series events without their Bronze Medallion. To compete in ski events the competitor must be at least 15 years of age on the day of the event.

Course (see course map below for layout)

Board – approx. 600m (35&Over approx. 300m – 1 section)

Ski – approx. 1200m (35&Over approx. 600m – 1 section)

Note: Course directions and lengths may be altered at the discretion of the event organiser. Competitors will be notified of the final course at the pre-race briefing (8.45am)



**Start**

Board start will be as per normal dry land board start.

Ski start will be a water start.

Finish

The finish for both board & ski events will be a dry land finish.

In both the board and ski events the competitor must be in contact with and have control of their craft (and paddle in the case of the ski events) when crossing the finish line. The finish will be judged on the chest of the competitor.
