## **COURSES**

Courses will be finalised at the pre-race briefing to be conducted 15 minutes before the start of the event.

### **ROUND 1 – THE PUNISHER**

#### **SKI'S**

Event 1 = 4km - 20 minute time frame before next event  
Mass Start 2 x 2km circuits

Event 2 = 2km – 10 minute time frame before next event  
Mass Start 1 x 2km circuit

Event 3 = 1km – 5 minute time frame before next event  
Mass Start

Event 4 = 500m  
Male and Female Start

#### **BOARDS**

Event 1 = 2km - 20 minute time frame before next event  
Mass Start 1 x 2km circuits

Event 2 = 1km – 10 minute time frame before next event  
Mass Start 1 x 1km circuit

Event 3 = 500m – 5 minute time frame before next event  
Mass Start

Event 4 = 250m  
Male and Female Start

The winner in each category will be determined by the highest number of points accumulated over the 4 x events.

### **ROUND 2 – THE SURVIVOR**

Eliminator style racing

- 3 x 5 – 7 minute sprint races 'M Course' – a percentage of field drops off each race
- Four minutes rest from 1st across line
- Race till the final four are reached
- Four minute break after each heat taken from the winner's finish time
- Board's will race first
- All race's will be drag finishes

### **ROUND 3 – THE HUNTER**

- 4 x 250m Short Course Sprint Races (Round Robin Format)
- Points determine an A & B final
- Same format for Board paddlers over 300m

#### **ENTRY FEE AND CONDITIONS**

- \$10.00 entry fee (Can enter board and ski for this fee) per round
- Entries will open on-line via [www.mybeach.com.au](http://www.mybeach.com.au)
- Entries will close 11pm on the Wednesday prior to each respective round
- Late entries will be accepted up to half an hour prior to the start time of the event at \$20 per entry
- Clubs will be invoiced directly for all entries

### **SERIES FORMAT**

#### **ROUND 1 – SPRINT ESCALATOR**

- 3 x 90m Sprints
- Competitors seeded into grades
- Two rounds where bottom two of each grade goes down and top two of each grade go up
- Third round becomes the final and decides the placing i.e. A grade top eight places, B grade 9-16 etc
- All three rounds raced back to back, one age group at a time

#### **FLAGS ENDURO**

- All the flags will be conducted with only 30 seconds rest between each run. Once age group at a time

#### **ROUND 2 – STATE RELAY CHALLENGE**

- 70m State Relay Challenge – four round point score (four age group categories)

- Late entries will be accepted up to half an hour prior to the start time of the event
